



PARENTS INTRODUCTION:


"<u>CHILD OF GOD</u>" is the official religious recognition program of the Catholic Committee on Scouting, Archdiocese of Santa Fe designed for Kindergarten students

The purpose of this award is to make the student aware of the role they play in their family, Church, and friends. The family is the setting in which we learn to relate to God, and others. In the family we learn what it means to love and to be loved, and what it means to be a person.

The requirements are addressed to the child. However, the adult advisor will need to read and explain them to her. The adult advisor is urged to assist the child by talking about the experiences which make up the program. There are many activities in this workbook. There is space here to color, to write, to draw, and to paste pictures.

The program is primarily to serve girls of the Catholic faith; however, if a non-Catholic desires to participate, she may do so with permission of her parents.



GENESIS 7:2-3


MAKE A FAMILY FLAG

Read the scripture passage below and talk about ways family members can do good and share with each other.

LOVE IS KIND

"Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, love is not pompous, is not inflated. It is not rude, it does not seek its own interests; it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrong-doing, but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, hopes all things, endures all things. In the end, there remains these three: Faith, Hope, and Love, but the greatest of these is Love." (1 Cor.13)

After discussing this, construct a "Family Flag" or banner. After your child completes the flag, help her write her name, or the family name on the flag. She may want to include the names of each family member. Hang it where the family can see or talk about it.



Draw or paste a picture of you helping or doing something nice for a family member, neighbor, or friend. (Example: bring flowers to a sick neighbor or friend; help do the dishes or yard work; help someone in a special way that shows you care about them just as Jesus shows us that He cares for us. This is what Jesus taught us in the story of the Good Samaritan.

For our food.


At Night

Grace - After Meals


When your family is gathered for dinner, say a special prayer thanking Jesus for your family, and letting your family know that you love them.



Have someone in your family read you this bible story. Color the picture on the next page.




DANIEL IN THE LION'S DEN

(Dn 6:17-25)

The next morning the king went sorrowfully to the lions den. "O Daniel," he cried, "Servant of the living God, has the God whom you constantly serve been able to save you from the lions?" Daniel answered, "O King, live forever. My God has sent His Angel and closed the mouths of the lions so that they have not hurt me, for I have been found innocent before Him; neither to you have I done any harm, O King!"

Overjoyed, the king ordered him removed from the lions den. King Darius then ordered the men and their families who had falsely accused Daniel to be cast into the lions den.



King Darius was very sorry that Daniel had been thrown into the Lion's den and was happy that God had saved his friend. Daniel's great faith in God saved him from the hungry lions.


